BARE WINE TOURS - COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

QUICK FACTS ABOUT COVID-19

- Coronavirus is a respiratory illness that spreads from person to person
- Severe cases can cause pneumonia and/or organ failure
- Main symptoms include fever, dry cough, and shortness of breath
- Its incubation period include fever, dry cough, and shortness of breath
- Its incubation period is about 2 weeks
- Some infected people are asymptomatic, meaning they will not experience symptoms
- People infected by the virus are contagious during the incubation period
- The virus can last up to 3 hours in the air and is found after up to 17 days on surfaces
- It is more dangerous than the seasonal flu

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

Wash hands frequently

The virus particle itself is held together by a lipid bilayer that acts as "glue" that holds each part of the virus together. Antibacterial soap and water are very effective at dissolving this bilayer, thus disassembling the virus and making it inactive. When hand washing isn't possible, use the hand sanitizer provided.

• Disinfecting commonly touched services frequently

Use disinfectant to clean door handles, seat belts, ipad, steering wheel, and other frequently touched surfaces.

Social Distancing

The virus' main mode of transmission is from person-to-person contact and airborne droplets caused by coughing and sneezing. Distance yourself as much as possible, keeping 2m as the recommended guideline top of mind. Obey maximum occupancy signs.

Quarantine if you feel symptoms

If employees feel symptoms of COVID-19, stay at home for 2 weeks and self-isolate. If symptoms get worse or if they feel more severe, call a doctor before going in to get tested. Showing up unannounced can put others at risk.

Avoiding touching your face

Although the virus is mainly transmitted through the air, the CDC has said the virus can live on surfaces. If you touch an infected surface and then touch your eyes, nose, or mouth, the virus can enter your body.

• Covering coughs, sneezes and containing droplets/particles.

Cough and sneeze into your elbow, or a tissue and wash your hands immediately. Consider using a reusable daily washable facemask to limit the chances of you spreading germs to others.

Thoughtfulness & Extra COVID-19 Responsibilities

- Plastic coolers are the preferred option and please disinfect after each use. Please leave open to air dry.
- Laundry room is accessible to employees for a hand washing station at the start and end of your shift.
- Hand sanitizer and disinfectant are available throughout each tour
- I-pad is not to be shared with guests to manage spotify music.
- One payment method is encouraged. If this is not possible, please disinfect between guests
- If possible, please dispose of garbage at the gas station and not the BARE home base.
- Management will also regularly disinfect touch services and supplies throughout the home base and vehicles.
- Disinfect the BARE van at the beginning of your shift, throughout your tour and at the end of each day.
- Snacks provided will be in individual packaged containers e.g. bags of chips.
- Drivers and guests will review daily signage of COVID-19 testimony, and guide's health review.
